Important Procedures*

Front doors to the school do not open until 7:15 a.m. Students arriving at school prior to 7:15 will sit on the benches outside school until the doors open. There will be no supervision for students until 7:15. Breakfast will be served in students' classrooms from 7:30 am- 8:00 am.

Morning Drop-off: All car riders will be dropped off in the car rider loop. <u>Please do not drive through the staff parking lot to drop off your student.</u>

BE ON TIME! <u>School begins at 8:00 a.m.</u> Students who are not <u>in</u> their classrooms at 8:00 will be marked tardy.

Afternoon Pick-up: No left turn off of Talbotton Road into the car rider line, right turn only.

If your child has an appointment that requires you to check him/her out of school early, please make sure you come to the school prior to 2:00 p.m. Students cannot be checked out after 2:00 p.m. Students will have to wait for dismissal times.

Car riders will be dismissed starting at 2:15 p.m. For parents who walk up, students will begin to be called for dismissal at 2:30 p.m.

Parents/Guardians will be not allowed to enter the building during dismissal.
